## DELIVERY AND ASSESSMENT

Programmes are delivered and assessed by experts in the sector. All programmes are designed to meet the needs of the organisation. As such content will be adapted and specific organisational documentation and policies embedded.

Training for all programmes is ideally delivered in group training sessions and assessment is completed via workbooks/discussions (for Non-NVQs), with additional observations, discussions and witness testimonies for NVQs. On successful completion and assessment, accredited certificates are provided from the relevant awarding body such as City & Guilds.

## FUNDING AND CHARGES

As a training provider on the Governments Register of Training Organisations and Apprenticeship Training Providers, we may be able to access funding to subsidise the costs of some of these programmes. A range of eligibility criteria applies to this funding such as the candidate(s) being unemployed (for community funding) or the individual being in full time employment (for apprenticeship funding).

Where candidates do not meet this criteria, competitive training rates are charged.

## APPRENTICESHIPS AND LEVY FUNDING

The L2 and L3 NVQ in Spectator Safety may be fundable via the companys Apprenticeship Levy or Mitre's funding for non-levy paying employers. For this, the candidate(s) completes this as an Apprenticeship programme and therefore must be working for the employer full time and must complete relevant maths and english functional skills alongside their NVQ. If the company pays the Apprenticeship Levy, the cost of the programme should be covered. If the company is not paying into the Apprenticeship Levy, they must pay 10% of the training costs.
